



2001 – 2018 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- The Pennsylvania Department of Education has awarded the Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership four **three-year \$1.235 million** 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grants to provide out of school time and summer programming to middle school students in Philadelphia.
- The United States Department of Education awarded the Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership (PAEP) its second **four year \$1.1 million** Arts in Education Model Development and Dissemination Grant for *Arts Link: Building Mathematics and Science Competencies through an Arts Integration Model* in 2010 to work in The School District of Philadelphia (SDP).
- The United States Department of Education awarded the Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership and The School District of Philadelphia a four-year Arts in Education Model Development and Dissemination Grant for *Arts Bridges: Building Literacy through an Integrated Arts Collaborative Model* in 2006.
- PAEP was recognized by **Michelle Obama** as an exemplary arts education organization for its work on *Arts Link*.
- PAEP has been acknowledge by the President’s Committee on the Arts and Humanities (2011) report for the design and implementation of the Nation’s first teaching artist certificate program in collaboration with the PA Council on the Arts.
- **100,000** students worked with over **900** teaching artists in a PAEP **\$2.5 million** summer enrichment program funded by The School District of Philadelphia from 2009-2011.
- PAEP was awarded a grant from the National Endowment of the Arts for a new after school literacy and arts program in Free Library of Philadelphia sites.
- Scholastic Young Artists and Writers Awards Program selected PAEP to be its regional partner to manage the regional competition. PAEP is one of three sites across the country to host the national exhibition.
- In 2004, the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts selected the Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership as its regional partner in Arts in Education to select and train artists and design and implement arts residencies for southeastern Pennsylvania.
- PAEP manages the regional southeastern Pennsylvania Poetry Out Loud competition for the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts. This poetry recitation competition for high school students is a program of the National Endowment for the Arts.
- **310,311** students have engaged in hands-on arts making experiences for 10 days or more, working with **4,377** artists representing all of the performing and visual art disciplines through PAEP’s in-school, after-school, community sites, and summer Arts Residency Programs since 2001.
- **5,401** teachers have participated in PAEP-sponsored arts-integration residencies and professional development programs.
- **90** regional arts and cultural institutions are participating organization with PAEP.
- In 2015, PAEP launched model arts residency programs for seniors and PreK populations throughout the southeastern PA.
