

## **Narrative Program Design**

### **a. 9. Performance Indicators/Metrics**

**Indicator/Metric 1.1:** 15% or greater increase in the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards for performance in the ELA subtest of the PSSA for students in grades 4-8 participating in 21CCLC programming during the school year and summer. 10% or greater increase in the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards for performance in the Math subtest of the PSSA for students in grades 4-8 participating in 21CCLC programming during the school year and summer.

**Indicator/Metric 1.2:** 40% of students in grades 7-8 and 10-12 attending 21CCLC programming during the school year and summer with a prior year with an unweighted grade point average (GPA) less than 3.0 will demonstrate an improved GPA.

**Indicator/Metric 2.1:** 60% of students participating in 21CCLC programming who had less than 90% attendance in the prior year will show increases in school attendance rates.

**Indicator/Metric 2.2:** 65% of students in grades 1-5 participating in 21CCLC programming in the school year and summer will demonstrate improvement in teacher reported engagement in learning.

**Indicator/Metric 3.1:** 30% of students grades 1-12 attending 21CCLC programming during the school year and summer will experience a decrease in in-school suspensions as compared to the previous school year. (Grades 5-8)

**Indicator/Metric 4.1:** 50% or more of students participating in 21CCLC will have parent(s)/caregiver(s) involvement in family engagement activities.
